## Host a House Party

### Business Connector’s Role

A house party host is responsible for providing the space for an event and for inviting their guests. Generally, hosts also cover the cost of the event. Women’s Initiative staff will work with you to set achievable goals, make a clear plan, and ensure the success of your event. The host will inspire their guests with their commitment and will encourage others to get involved in our work.

### Time Commitment

15-20 hours.

Women’s Initiative staff will work with you to develop a task list and action plan. Staff will also support you in your planning process. The time commitment of the host varies from event to event.
